H1062 (*b* ôrâ, pronounced bek-o-raw'); meaning birthright, primogeniture, right of the first-born. Translated birthright 9 times, firstling 5 times and firstborn 1 time.

H1067 (*b* îrâ, pronounced bek-ee-raw'); meaning firstborn daughter, firstborn (of women), always used of women

H1069 *(bakar, pronounced* baw-kar'); meaning to bear new fruit, to constitute as first-born.

H6363 (peter, pronounced peh'-ter); meaning that which separates or first opens.

G4416 (prototokos, pronounced pro-tot-ok'-os); meaning first-born, eldest.

<sup>51</sup>Joseph called the name of the firstborn *(H1060)* Manasseh: *(Causing to forget)* "For Yehovah has made me forget all my toil and all my father's house."

<sup>33</sup>And they (*Joseph's servants*) sat before him, the firstborn (*H1060*) according to his birthright and the youngest according to his youth; and the men looked in astonishment at one another.

### Gen 48:14

<sup>14</sup>Then Israel stretched out his right hand and laid *it* on Ephraim's head, who was the younger, and his left hand on Manasseh's head, guiding his hands knowingly, for Manasseh was the firstborn (*H1060. (The firstborn should get the greater blessing.*)

### Gen 48:18

<sup>18</sup>And Joseph said to his father, "Not so, my father, for this *one is* the firstborn *(H1060)*; put your right hand on his head."

### Gen 49:3

<sup>3</sup>"Reuben, you are my firstborn (*H1060*), my might and the beginning of my strength, the excellency of dignity and the excellency of power.

# Exodus 4:22-23

<sup>22</sup>Then you shall say to Pharaoh, 'Thus says Yehovah: "Israel *is* My son, My firstborn *(H1060)*. *(Jer 31:9; Rom 9:4; II Cor 6:18)* <sup>23</sup>So I say to you, let My son go that he may serve Me. But if you refuse to let him go, indeed I will kill your son, your firstborn *(H1060)*.""

### Exodus 6:14

<sup>14</sup>These *are* the heads of their fathers' houses: The sons of Reuben (*a son*), the firstborn (*H1060*) of Israel, were Hanoch (*dedicated*), Pallu (*wonderful*), Hezron (*enclosed*, *arrow of song: division of song*), and Carmi (*my vineyard*). These are the families of Reuben.

### Exodus 11:5

# Exodus 13:12-13, 15

<sup>12</sup>that you shall set apart to Yehovah all that open the womb, that is, every firstborn (*H6363*) that comes from an animal which you have; the males *shall be* Yehovah's. <sup>13</sup>But every firstborn of a donkey (*Unclean animal*) you shall redeem with a lamb; and if you will not redeem *it*, then you shall break its neck. And all the firstborn (*H6363*) of man among your sons you shall redeem. <sup>15</sup>And it came to pass, when Pharaoh was stubborn about letting us go, that Yehovah killed all the firstborn (*H1060*) in the land of Egypt, both the firstborn (*H1060*) of man and the firstborn (*H1060*) of beast. <sup>19</sup>"All that open the womb *are* Mine, and every male firstborn (*H6363*) among your livestock, *whether* ox or sheep. (*Ex 13:2*) <sup>20</sup>But the firstborn (*H6363*) of a donkey you shall redeem with a lamb. And if you will not redeem *him,* then you shall break his neck. All the firstborn (*H1060*) of your sons you shall redeem. "And none shall appear before Me empty-handed.

### Leviticus 27:26

<sup>26</sup>'But the firstborn *(H1060)* of the animals, which should be Yehovah's firstborn *(H1069)*, no man shall dedicate; whether *it is* an ox or sheep, it *is* Yehovah's.

### Numbers 3:2

<sup>2</sup>And these *are* the names of the sons of Aaron: Nadab, *(the willing one)* the firstborn *(H1060)*, and Abihu *(Father of him)*, Eleazar *(My God is a rock)*, and Ithamar *(Palm-coast)*.

<sup>50</sup>From the firstborn *(H1060)* of the children of Israel he took the money, one thousand three hundred and sixty-five *shekels*, according to the shekel of the sanctuary.

# Numbers 8:16-18

<sup>16</sup>For they (*The Levites*) are wholly given to Me from among the children of Israel; I have taken them for Myself instead of all who open the womb, the firstborn (*H1060*) of all the children of Israel. <sup>17</sup>For all the firstborn (*H1060*) among the children of Israel are Mine, *both* man and beast; on the day that I struck all the firstborn (*H1060*) in the land of Egypt I sanctified them to Myself. <sup>18</sup>I have taken the Levites instead of all the firstborn (*H1060*) of the children of Israel.

# Numbers 18:15-17

<sup>15</sup>"Everything that first opens the womb of all flesh, which they bring to Yehovah, whether man or beast, shall be yours; nevertheless, the firstborn *(H1060)* of man you

shall surely redeem, and the firstborn *(H1060)* of unclean animals you shall redeem. <sup>16</sup>And those redeemed of the devoted things you shall redeem when one month old, according to your valuation, for five shekels of silver, according to the shekel of the sanctuary, which *is* twenty gerahs. <sup>17</sup>But the firstborn *(H1060)* of a cow, the firstborn *(H1060)* of a sheep, or the firstborn *(H1060)* of a goat you shall not redeem; they *are* holy. You shall sprinkle their blood on the altar, and burn their fat *as* an offering made by fire for a sweet aroma to Yehovah.

### Numbers 26:5

<sup>5</sup>Reuben *was* the firstborn *(H1060)* of Israel. The children of Reuben *were: of* Hanoch, the family of the Hanochites; *of* Pallu, the family of the Palluites;

### Numbers 33:4

<sup>4</sup>For the Egyptians were burying all *their* firstborn (*H1060*), whom Yehovah had killed among them. Also, on their gods Yehovah had executed judgments.

### Deut 12:6

<sup>6</sup>There you shall take your burnt offerings, your sacrifices, your tithes, the heave offerings of your hand, your vowed offerings, your freewill offerings, and the firstborn *(H1062)* of your herds and flocks.

### Deut 15:19

<sup>19</sup>"All the firstborn (*H1060*) males that come from your herd and your flock you shall sanctify to Yehovah your God; you shall do no work with the firstborn (*H1060*) of your herd, nor shear the firstborn (*H1060*) of your flock.

# Deut 21:15

<sup>15</sup>"If a man has two wives, one loved and the other unloved, and they have borne him children, *both* the loved and the unloved, and *if* the firstborn (*H1069*) son is of her who is unloved, <sup>16</sup>then it shall be, on the day he bequeaths his possessions to his sons, *that* he must not bestow firstborn (*H1069*) status on the son of the loved wife in preference to the son of the unloved, the *true* firstborn (*H1060*). <sup>17</sup>But he shall acknowledge the son of the

unloved wife *as* the firstborn (*H1060*) by giving him a double portion of all that he has, for he *is* the beginning of his strength; the right of the firstborn(*H1062*) *is* his.

### Deut 25:6

<sup>6</sup>And it shall be *that* the firstborn *(H1060)* son which she bears will succeed to the name of his dead brother, that his name may not be blotted out of Israel.

## Deut 33:17

<sup>17</sup>His glory *is like* a firstborn (*H1060*) bull, and his horns *like* the horns of the wild ox; together with them he shall push the peoples to the ends of the earth; they *are* the ten thousands of Ephraim, and they *are* the thousands of Manasseh."

### Joshua 6:26

<sup>26</sup>Then Joshua charged *them* at that time, saying, "Cursed *be* the man before Yehovah who rises up and builds this city Jericho; he shall lay its foundation with his firstborn *(H1060)*, and with his youngest he shall set up its gates."

<sup>49</sup>The sons of Saul were Jonathan, Jishui, and Malchishua. And the names of his two daughters *were these:* the name of the firstborn (*H1067*) Merab (*Increasing*), and the name of the younger Michal.

### I Samuel 17:13

<sup>13</sup>The three oldest sons of Jesse had gone to follow Saul to the battle. The names of his three sons who went to the battle *were* Eliab (*My God is Father*) the firstborn (*H1060*), next to him Abinadab, and the third Shammah.

### II Samuel 3:2

<sup>2</sup>Sons were born to David in Hebron: His firstborn (*H1060*) was Amnon (*Faithful*) by Ahinoam (*Brother of Pleasantness*) the Jezreelitess;

I Kings 16:34

<sup>34</sup>In his days Hiel of Bethel built Jericho. He laid its foundation with Abiram (*My father is exalted*) his firstborn (*H1060*), and with his youngest *son* Segub he set up its gates, according to the word of Yehovah, which He had spoken through Joshua the son of Nun.

I Chronicles 1:13 <sup>13</sup>Canaan begot Sidon *(Hunting)*, his firstborn *(H1060)*, and Heth;

<sup>13</sup>Jesse begot Eliab (*My God is Father*) his firstborn (*H1060*), Abinadab the second, Shimea the third,

I Chronicles 2:25

<sup>25</sup>The sons of Jerahmeel (*May God show mercy*), the firstborn (*H1060*) of Hezron, *were* Ram (*High*), the firstborn (*H1060*), and Bunah, Oren, Ozem, *and* Ahijah.

I Chronicles 2:27

<sup>27</sup>The sons of Ram *(High)*, the firstborn *(H1060)* of Jerahmeel, were Maaz, Jamin, and Eker.

I Chronicles 2:42

<sup>42</sup>The descendants of Caleb the brother of Jerahmeel *were* Mesha (*Bringing deliverance*), his firstborn (*H1060*), who was the father of Ziph, and the sons of Mareshah the father of Hebron.

I Chronicles 2:50

<sup>50</sup>These were the descendants of Caleb: The sons of Hur (*A hole, white*), the firstborn (*H1060*) of Ephrathah, *were* Shobal the father of Kirjath Jearim,

I Chronicles 3:1

<sup>1</sup> Now these were the sons of David who were born to him in Hebron: The firstborn *(H1060) was* Amnon *(Faithful)*, by Ahinoam the Jezreelitess; the second, Daniel, by Abigail the Carmelitess;

I Chronicles 3:15

<sup>15</sup>The sons of Josiah *were* Johanan (*Yehovah is gracious giver*) the firstborn (*H1060*), the second Jehoiakim, the third Zedekiah, and the fourth Shallum.

I Chronicles 4:4

<sup>4</sup>and Penuel *was* the father of Gedor, and Ezer *was the* father of Hushah. These *were* the sons of Hur, the firstborn *(H1060)* of Ephrathah the father of Bethlehem.

<sup>30</sup>And his *(Gibeon's)* firstborn *(H1060)* son *was* Abdon *(Servitude)*, then Zur, Kish, Baal, Nadab,

I Chronicles 8:39

<sup>39</sup>And the sons of Eshek his brother *were* Ulam (*Their leader, vestibule*) his firstborn (*H1060*), Jeush the second, and Eliphelet the third.

I Chronicles 9:5

<sup>5</sup>Of the Shilonites: Asaiah (Same as preceding) the firstborn (H1060) and his sons.

I Chronicles 9:31

<sup>31</sup>Mattithiah (*Gift of Yehovah*) of the Levites, the firstborn (*H1060*) of Shallum the Korahite, had the trusted office over the things that were baked in the pans.

I Chronicles 9:36

<sup>36</sup>His firstborn *(H1060)* son *was* Abdon *(Servitude)*, then Zur, Kish, Baal, Ner, Nadab, <sup>37</sup>Gedor, Ahio, Zechariah, and Mikloth.

# I Chronicles 26:2

<sup>2</sup>And the sons of Meshelemiah *were* Zechariah *(Remembered of Yehovah)* the firstborn *(H1060)*, Jediael the second, Zebadiah the third, Jathniel the fourth, <sup>3</sup>Elam the fifth, Jehohanan the sixth, Eliehoenai the seventh.

# I Chronicles 26:4

<sup>4</sup>Moreover the sons of Obed-Edom *were* Shemaiah (*The harkening of Yah, Heard of Yehovah*) the firstborn (*H1060*), Jehozabad the second, Joah the third, Sacar the fourth, Nethanel the fifth,

# I Chronicles 26:10

<sup>10</sup>Also Hosah, of the children of Merari, had sons: Shimri (*My keeper, watchful*) the first (for *though* he was not the firstborn (*H1060*), his father made him the first),

# II Chronicles 21:3

<sup>3</sup>Their father gave them great gifts of silver and gold and precious things, with fortified cities in Judah; but he gave the kingdom to Jehoram (*Yehovah is exalted*), because he *was* the firstborn (*H1060*).

<sup>7</sup>And she *(Mary)* brought forth her firstborn *(G4416)* Son, and wrapped Him in swaddling cloths, and laid Him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn.

Romans 8:29

<sup>29</sup>For whom He <u>foreknew</u> (Knew us in the past at our beginning) (Acts 26:4-5; Rom 11:1-2; I Cor 8:3; II Tim 2:19), He also <u>predestined</u> (Eph 1:5, 11) to be conformed (II Cor 3:18) to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn (G4416) among many brethren. (Heb 1:6)

Colossians 1:15

<sup>15</sup>He (Yeshua) is the <u>image</u> (in likeness as a statue that represents the resemblance) of the <u>invisible</u> (unseen) God, (John 4:24; II Cor 4:4, John 14:9) the firstborn (G4416) over all creation. (Rom 8:9)

Colossians 1:18

<sup>18</sup>And He *(Christ)* is the head of the body, the church *(ecclesia)*, who is the beginning, the firstborn *(G4416)* from the dead, that in all things He may have the preeminence.

Hebrews 1:6

<sup>6</sup>But when scripture says (the psalmists) again (by repetition once more) he <u>brings</u> (by introduction) <u>the</u> <u>firstborn</u> (G4416) (Rom 8:29) into the world, it says: "Let all the angels of <u>God</u> (Yehovah) worship <u>Him</u> (Yeshua)." (Deut 32:43; Ps 97:7)

Hebrews 11:28

<sup>28</sup>By faith he kept the Passover and the sprinkling of blood, (Ex 12:21) lest he who destroyed the firstborn (*G4416*) should touch them.

Hebrews 12:23

<sup>23</sup>to the general assembly and <u>church of the firstborn</u> who are registered in heaven, *(In the book of Life)* to God the Judge of all, to the spirits of just men <u>made perfect</u>,

Revelation 1:5

<sup>5</sup>and from <u>Jesus Christ, who is the faithful</u> (*trustworthy*) <u>witness</u>, and firstborn (*G4416*) (*begotten*) from the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood,

# Greek and Hebrew Words for Birthright

Birthright is translated from the following Hebrew and Greek words:

H1062 (*b* ôrâ, pronounced bek-o-raw) meaning; birthright, primogeniture, right of the first-born

G4415 (*prōtotokia*, pronounced pro-tot-ok'-ee-ah) meaning; the right or advantages of the first-born son

Websters meaning of Birthright: a right, privilege, or possession to which a person is entitled by birth.

Synonyms: bequest, claim, due, inheritance, legacy, patrimony, primogeniture, right, share.

# **Birthright Scriptures**

Genesis 25:31 – 34

<sup>31</sup>But Jacob said, "Sell me your birthright *(H1062)* as of this day." <sup>32</sup>And Esau said, "Look, I *am* about to die; so what *is* this birthright *(H1062)* to me?" <sup>33</sup>Then Jacob said, "Swear to me as of this day." So he swore to him, and sold his birthright *(H1062)* to Jacob. <sup>34</sup>And Jacob gave Esau bread and stew of lentils; then he ate and drank, arose, and went his way. Thus Esau despised *his* birthright. *(H1062)* 

Genesis 27:36

<sup>36</sup>And *Esau* said, "Is he not rightly named Jacob? For he has supplanted me these two times. He took away my birthright (*H1062*), and now look, he has taken away my blessing!" And he said, "Have you not reserved a blessing for me?"

Genesis 43:33

<sup>33</sup>And they (*Joseph's servants*) sat before him, the firstborn according to his birthright (*H1062*) and the youngest according to his youth; and the men looked in astonishment at one another.

### I Chronicles 5:1-2

<sup>1</sup> Now the sons of Reuben the firstborn of Israel—he *was* indeed the firstborn, but because he defiled his father's bed, his birthright *(H1062)* was given to the sons of Joseph, the son of Israel, so that the genealogy is not listed according to the birthright; *(H1062) (Gen 35:22; 41:4)* <sup>2</sup>yet Judah prevailed over his brothers, and from him *came* a ruler, although the birthright was Joseph's—

Hebrews 12:16

<sup>16</sup>lest there *be* any fornicator or profane person like Esau, who for one morsel of food sold his birthright.
