It's September the 26th of 2024 and this is Eighth Day, the final day of us getting together during this festival time. Stepping back from the usual feast hubbub, there was one thing that stood out to me, perhaps you've noticed it too. Both from the speaker's perspective and in general fellowship, it was obvious what mattered is what the Bible, our Father said, and not what a church taught about what it said.

0:00:34

All the references to the Church are just gone. The people here are looking to the scriptures; what does our Dad tell us? It's not about what does the church tell us that our Father said to us. To a man, to a person that I listened to. So, that stuck out to me. Just stepping back from the fray, and saying, "You know", here's a group of folks that are concerned about what God says, and they go for reference to the Bible, not to the teachings of an organization.

0:01:16

And that could be the Church of God, or anything, it doesn't matter. That's what people do, they look to a church or a person, and that filter seemed to be removed here. And the contact, if you will, was between the individual and Christ. But Christ always pointing to the will of Yehovah.

0:01:42

There were no exceptions to that, He didn't point to Himself. With Christ openly teaching that the ekklesia are those that do the will of God, this shouldn't be any kind of a surprise to any of us. If Christ is our head, and He points us to the Father, that one on one encounter with Yehovah would be a natural result.

0:02:07

Loving Yehovah and having no other God before Him, would fulfill the first commandment, would it not? I told a friend of mine some time ago, that we need to stop breaking the first commandment, and their eyes grew a size or two. They actually thought that statement seemed totally out of place.

0:02:33

And they were a very staunch church going person, and to even suggest that he was breaking the first commandment was shocking to him that I even said it. But it's true, all of us were, back in the day. That's just my observation, yours may be different. It takes courage to step out and begin to be eyeball to eyeball to our Father.

0:03:01

Many will not make such an adjustment, and there are a variety of reasons for not doing so. That's not where we are going today, I just wanted to point that out. What we are actually part of is expressed in Luke 10; Luke 10:22. It's in other places in the scriptures as well, but I'll just add this here in these opening remarks. Christ speaking.

²²All things have been delivered to Me by My Father, and no one knows who the Son is except the Father, and who the Father is except the Son,

And notice:

and the one to whom the Son wills to reveal Him."

0:03:50

So, has Christ chosen to reveal the Father to this ragtag group of people sitting in this room? And I think that the answer is yes, I believe that. Think about that, how many people actually want to have the Father revealed to them? I don't think very many, from what my experience has been.

0:04:31

So, Christ does this, it's not through any genius in our part. I think this is true, and I believe it is, He's chosen, Christ Himself has chosen to reveal the Father to us. If He didn't do that the chances of us knowing the Father would be about this many. (Held up a hand forming a zero)

0:04:59

So, it's not through any genius on our part, and yet He has chosen to do that. So, He must have seen in each of us some capacity to want to know about the Father, or why else would He even bother? So, that's just something to think about.

0:05:26

Sufice it to say when scriptures come into focus it would cause us to question some official narrative; we need to count the cost of doing so. I would like to take a look at a couple of scriptures mentioned in last Sabbath's message that are indeed contrary to long held traditional understanding.

0:05:44

For without considering all the pieces of the puzzle, or at least more of them, how can the meaning of the Eighth Day become visible through the fog, if we are not willing to look at all the possible references that would give us understanding? Further, do we really want to know? And if it causes some discomfort, as we begin to know, would we just look away, because we don't want to know?

0:06:17

Now all of these things just come out. So, let's consider Daniel 12, verses 1 - 10, once again.

¹ "At that time Michael shall stand up, the great prince who stands watch over the sons of your people; and there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation, even to that time.

0:06:43

So, it's going to get, at some point pretty crazy. At that time, and you can actually go into II Thessalonians 2 and see what that time is. When you see a personality showing up in the middle east, claiming he's God, hold on to your hat, because the resurrection, the first resurrection of the barley is very close.

0:07:03

It tells us that.

... everyone who is found written in the book.

The book of life. And also, at that time.

²And many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, some to shame and everlasting contempt.

0:07:27

So, is there going to be a physical resurrection of people at this very time? Of course! That's what it says. It doesn't say everybody, it says many. Even with that, and we can see the timing. Our historical understanding that the second resurrection happens at the end of this millennial period, is false; it has to be. It doesn't fit.

0:08:05

Well, why are they coming to life? Well, let's see.

³Those who are wise shall shine like the brightness of the firmament, and those who turn many to righteousness like the stars forever and ever.

So, they are going to have a job, they are resurrected, and they have a job to turn many to righteousness. Well, that sounds kind of Evangelical Protestant, doesn't it?

0:08:29

That can't be true? That's what it says. So, we go on.

⁴"But you, Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book until the time of the end; many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall increase." ⁵Then I, Daniel, looked; and there stood two others, one on this riverbank and the other on that riverbank. ⁶ And one said to the man clothed in linen, who was above the waters of the river, "How long shall the fulfillment of these wonders be?" ⁷Then I heard the man clothed in linen, who was above the waters of the river, when he held up his right hand and his left hand to heaven, and swore by Him who lives forever, that it shall be for a time, times, and half a time; and when the power of the holy people has been completely shattered.

0:09:19

We need to think about that.

all these things shall be finished. ⁸Although I heard; I did not understand. Then I said, "My lord, what shall be the end of these things?" ⁹And he said, "Go your way, Daniel, for the words are closed up and sealed till the time of the end.

But notice this:

¹⁰Many shall be purified, made white, and refined,

I counsel you to go buy gold refined in the fire. Is God going to raise people physically to live through this time to see whether they are on His side or on team dark? Sure, sounds like it to me.

0:09:58

That does not fit our historical paradigm at all. But there's more. So, it's a time of separation and choice. Some are going to be purified and white and refined.

but the wicked shall do wickedly; and none of the wicked shall understand, but the wise shall understand.

0:10:15

So, we can see this separation, this time of judgment and it tells us when the time is. But, that's not what we were taught. Okay, Let's look at Revelation 11; let's go to Revelation 11, we're going to look at verses 15 - 18.

¹⁵Then the seventh angel sounded: And there were loud voices in heaven, saying, "The kingdoms of this world have become the kingdoms of our LORD (The Father) and of His Christ.

0:10:54

And in our historical understanding, the Father is nowhere to be seen.

¹⁶And the twenty-four elders who sat before God (Yehovah) on their thrones fell on their faces and worshiped God, ¹⁷saying: "We give You thanks, O Lord God Almighty,

0:11:12

And the Lord God Almighty, to many brothers and sisters is Jesus Christ. The Lord God Almighty is not, to many of the people in the Church of God community.

the One who is and who was and who is to come, because You have taken Your great power and reigned.

0:11:37

The nations were really happy about that. No.

¹⁸The nations were angry, and Your wrath has come, and the time of the dead, that they should be judged,

Well, if you're going to judge the dead, would it seem logical that they would be resurrected, so you could judge them? Yeah!

and that You should reward Your servants the prophets and the saints, and those who fear Your name, small and great, ...

0:12:15

So, here we have a judgment of the dead, and we have a rewarding of the saints who have been given positions of rulership and responsibility. Does this sound like the end of the thousand years to anybody? No! But there's more.

0:12:35

So, let's go back to Daniel, and we'll go into Daniel 7. These are all scriptures that I touched on, did anybody actually go home and say, you know, I need to go home and look at those passages again and see what it says? Did anybody actually do that? So, let's go to Daniel 7, and we're going to read verses 7 – 12 again.

⁷ "After this I saw in the night visions, and behold, a fourth beast, dreadful and terrible, exceedingly strong. It had huge iron teeth; it was devouring, breaking in pieces, and trampling the residue with its feet. ...

0:13:11

Does this sound like the end of the thousand years to you, or does this sound like an end time thing, in this dispensation?

⁸I was considering the horns, and there was another horn, a little one, coming up among them, before whom three of the first horns were plucked out by the roots. And there, in this horn, were eyes like the eyes of a man, and a mouth speaking pompous words. ⁹"I watched till thrones were put in place,

0:13:41

You know, have we been guilty of not asking the questions who, what, when, where, and why?

and the Ancient of Days was seated;

Who's the Ancient of Days? It discusses Him. But notice the time frame, when? Well, it's when this beast power is active. We need to think about this a little bit. Well, what's He doing?

... and the hair of His head was like pure wool.

There's a description of His throne.

thousands ministered to Him; ...

And at the end of that.

The court was seated, and the books were opened.

And that's judgment was seated. At the time of the beast being active, how can that possibly be? And this is the Father, I thought that happened a thousand years down the road?

0:14:50

You know, by this time we should be starting to say, "Well, wait a minute, wait a minute, we have a problem." Is that going to happen at the end of the thousand years as well? Yup, sure is! My father is the vine dresser, I'm the vine and He cleans up, what He doesn't want. Oh, so we notice the time setting of this, and it's the same as in Revelation 7 or 11, and it's the same as Daniel 12, it's all the same.

0:15:31

You know, the word court in the New King James that I have here in the tail end of verse 10, is *din (dean) and its judgment*. Books is an archive, or house of records, and the word is Hebrew 5609.

0:15:55

The timing of such an event would seem obvious, but it immediately cross-threads with old ideas. It doesn't fit, to what we have historically understood. There are resurrections and judgments in places we wouldn't be looking, but if we stop and think for five seconds, we can say, "Well, wait a minute, we got us a problem here."

0:16:27

Rich touched on this one the other day, and I was wondering what he might say about it? Matthew 26:64; Matthew 26:64, I'll read verse 63 to set the text.

⁶³But Jesus kept silent. And the high priest answered and said to Him, "I put You under oath by the living God: tell us if You are the Christ, the Son of God!" ⁶⁴Jesus said to him, "It is as you said. Nevertheless, I say to you, hereafter you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Power,

0:17:12

Who's that? God the Father. Right.

and coming on the clouds of heaven."

So, when the Father and Christ return with the saints, this boy is going to see it. Where does that put the Resurrection of Caiaphas? Before the Father and Christ return. Well, that can't possibly be true because it matches with all those other scriptures. That's not what we understand.

0:17:45

Okay, so, we're not going to understand more deeply God's plan without incorporating these vignettes or snapshots into our puzzle picture. If you read a snapshot of time, and there is no place to put it, your concept and your paradigm is wrong. The scriptures are not wrong, you're wrong.

0:18:13

But if you nailed it to the wall and said this is the truth and can't teach anything else, how much can you learn? Answer, nothing. So, this is God's word, it's not mine. They all have to fit. It's going to happen, He doesn't lie.

0:18:38

One of the things we have been privileged to learn, is that there are three harvests to spirit. That's generally not understood, and they are all on the top line of the chart that I handed out the other day, which we've looked at recently. All three of those harvests are completed, as we'll see, before the next phase of man's tenure on the earth is in place.

0:19:09

We've never differentiated that before. Well, wait a minute, it's all here, no, no, it's not all here and this is God's plan. There are three feasts; the Feast of Unleavened Bread, that's the barley, the first harvest. And you have the feast of Pentecost, which is the wheat. And that's pictured in Revelation 15:2. And the final Ingathering of those who lived during Satan's influence, or control, however you would like to reference that space of time.

0:19:51

In the past we've failed to differentiate those, hiding them, as it were, from our consideration. We thought that they were all rolled up into a ball. We didn't see what God was actually doing. We did not differentiate them. And differentiating all of them isn't always well received.

0:20:14

You show somebody in the scriptures that there is a rapture, and here it is, and here's the barley harvest, see how that works out for you. This requires a mindset of elevating what God says, above the thoughts of men, not all will do this and not all will put God's will first, they just won't. And I'm sure all of us know, in our own lives, where we will not put God first, we won't do it. We know what His will is, but that's just not convenient, so we're just not going to do it.

0:20:52

You know, look in the mirror and see where we are all at. The barley will; they will walk with God, without having to be beat over the head. And the only way that we can be barley, is at a very individual level. I can't make you submit to God; I can't make myself submit to God, can't do it. But the barley does.

0:21:34

Mark Mickelson mentioned something really quite interesting. When you look at a barley plant, the head is drooped over, like beings in submission to God. The wheat is stiff and upright, it doesn't bend over and I had that imagery in my own mind, there is a difference between those two peoples.

0:21:55

But then he said, when you get to the third harvest, the grapes and the olives, they have to be squeezed to produce the fruit. They need further refinement, and I thought, you are right, that's what the third harvest is all about. So, I shamelessly stole the idea because it makes perfect sense, and I don't think it's an accident at all.

0:22:27

It's important to understand that the first and second resurrections, the harvest to spirit, are called firstfruits in scripture. The barley and the wheat are referred to as firstfruits. The Feast of Ingathering are not. The barley and the wheat harvest, the first two harvests to spirit, go to heaven, and they do so at different times.

0:23:02

I'm covering this because if we don't have some understanding of what the Feast of Tabernacles or the Feast of Ingathering represents, how will we come to understand the Eighth day that follows it? Answer, you can't, because they are in order.

0:23:24

So, if we look at trumpets as the return of the Father, Christ and the Saints, where were the first two harvests? Before then! There is no option, that's the only place that they fit. And we can actually see that; I mentioned that in Revelation 15:2, where we actually see the byproduct of the wheat harvest.

0:24:03

We'll read Revelation 15:1.

Well, the angels are there, he sees them, they haven't done what they are going to do.

¹ Then I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvelous: seven angels having the seven last plagues, for in them the wrath of God is complete.

²And I saw something like a sea of glass mingled with fire, and those who have the victory over the beast, over his image and over his mark and over the number of his name, standing on the sea of glass, having harps of God.

0:24:34

The sea of glass is before God's throne. Are these people in heaven? Yes! Have they received salvation? Yes! Did they face the beast? Yes, they did! And they were refined in it. But you notice, if you want to walk through this again, you see then these bowl plagues are actually poured out. Okay, what are they poured out on? The seat of the beast.

0:25:12

So, the beast is still active at this time, and the first two resurrections to spirit have already happened. Do we always logically look at this stuff and start asking questions? Ahm, no. No, actually we don't.

0:25:41

You can go to Revelation 16, and verses 13 and 14, because bowl plagues are being poured out, those people are already spirit and they have been spirit for a while; years. If you go to verse 13 and 14.

¹³And I saw three unclean spirits like frogs coming out of the mouth of the dragon, out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet. ¹⁴For they are spirits of demons, performing signs, which go out to the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty.

0:26:17

So, here you have Saints, resurrected in heaven, watching the bowl plagues being poured out on mankind. So, when we get to Revelation 20, verse 4 and 5.

⁴And I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was committed to them. Then I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for their witness to Jesus and for the word of God, who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received his mark on their foreheads or on their hands. And they lived and reigned with Christ for a thousand years.

0:27:02

What harvest is this talking about? The third harvest of mankind. The other two have already happened. So, what have we been taught previously; this is the first. Nope, it's the third. It's the last one. These folks have their heads lopped off. How long was it from the time they died until this resurrection moment happened? It does not tell us here. It tells us who they are, but it doesn't tell us, they might have been dead, how do we know that they hadn't been dead for a thousand years? I'm not saying that's the case, but we don't know. I don't know, that's for sure.

0:27:54

So, you can see where we took a scripture that applies to the third harvest of mankind and we're talking about it being the first, and we couldn't understand why we had a problem in our understanding. So, when we read these various resurrection events, we actually have to stop and think, like what's the deal here?

0:28:18

We chewed through it. The barley harvest is reflected in Revelation 14:1.

¹ Then I looked, and behold, a Lamb standing on Mount Zion, and with Him one hundred and forty-four thousand, having His Father's name written on their foreheads.

0:28:38

It doesn't say that about the others. That could be the case, but it doesn't say that. This group of people.

³They sang as it were a new song before the throne, before the four living creatures, and the elders; and no one could learn that song except (them) ...

0:29:02

The other group in Revelation 15:2, it doesn't say anything about that, nothing.

⁴These are the ones who were not defiled with women, for they are virgins. These are the ones who follow the Lamb wherever He goes. These were redeemed from among men, being firstfruits ...

0:29:19

So, is the barley harvest firstfruits? Yup, it says so.

⁵And in their mouth was found no deceit for they are without fault before the throne of God.

The wheat stand on the sea of glass, where are these guys standing? They're standing on Mount Zion. They are in a different place all together. Did these people face the beast power? Nope, no they didn't. So, you know, we just haven't historically separated those things out.

0:29:50

Hopefully we can see that the harvest of Revelation 20, verse 4 and 5, is referring to the final harvest of mankind, not the first one, not the second one; the third one. And they don't go to heaven, it says so. They're resurrected and they join those who are already ruling with Christ.

0:30:18

Okay, they (barley and wheat) are safely in heaven, resurrected spirit beings, whose life in eternity has already begun. Their role is to serve Yehovah in whatever manner He so desires. It talks about that in Revelation seven, they're there serving God night and day. And it's a fair bet that people who don't think that their purpose is to serve God night and day, won't be there. That is the purpose.

0:30:49

Both these of the second and third harvests, face the beast power; it says so. Who, as we read in Daniel 7, make war with the saints. If we go to Revelation 20; Revelation 20, let's read verses 7 - 10. Now, this is absolutely after the thousand years, as we will see.

⁷Now when the thousand years have expired,

0:31:36

And there has been no more resurrections for that period of time.

Satan will be released from his prison ⁸ and will go out to deceive the nations which are in the four corners of the earth,

And he will make a beast power and persecute the saints. What? Doesn't say that.

Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle, whose number is as the sand of the sea. ⁹They went up on the breadth of the earth and surrounded the camp of the saints and the beloved city. And fire came down from God (Yehovah) out of heaven and devoured them.

0:32:15

Is this the same thing we read about before? Or is this just totally different? If you look at that little sheet, that second line, that's where that occurs. And again, we've blurred and we've put everything together and mixed it and matched it, but when you actually take the time to separate it out, none of it fits.

0:32:42

The commentary here is one of rebellion and the subsequent vaporization of those who do. It's a totally different setting. These folks lived God's way for a thousand years, and we'll see that here in a bit. Whose hearts were not in it, and they went through the motions, but they really weren't with the program, and at the first real chance to attempt to offset the rules, and the chance for rebellion comes up, they take it. They do so.

0:33:17

And with the corresponding result. Fire comes down from God and just vaporizes them. Notice the symmetry. if you would, between the first timeline and the second timeline. What's the same? What's exactly the same is, everybody gets to dance. In the first timeline we come to understand the difference between Satan and God and you make your choice.

0:33:54

In the second timeline you completely understand the way of God, and God presents a second choice, or a different choice through Satan, and everybody makes the choice. Whether you are in this line, or in this line, everybody gets to dance, and makes their choice. It's exactly the same in the two dispensations.

0:34:24

So, where might we go to get a glimpse of this final harvest? You know, where would you turn in the scriptures that you can look at and read, now wait a minute, that's not this one, or that's not this one, that's that one? Where would you turn in the scriptures?

0:34:50

Can we see anything that might further point to the three harvests born of this time? Is there anything at all? How about Matthew 13, and let's take a look at verse 33.

³³Another parable He spoke to them: "The kingdom of heaven is like leaven,

And Austin spoke about that.

which a woman took and hid in three measures of meal till it was all leavened."

0:35:24

I now believe that is the three harvests that will each reach their fullness in this period of time in which we live. The three harvests of mankind. If we go on to verses 36 - 43 in the same passage.

³⁶Then Jesus sent the multitude away and went into the house. And His disciples came to Him, saying, "Explain to us the parable of the tares of the field."

0:35:57

Which was in the previous part of Matthew 13.

³⁷He answered and said to them: "He who sows the good seed is the Son of Man. ³⁸The field is the world, the good seeds are the sons of the kingdom, but the tares are the sons of the wicked one. ³⁹The enemy who sowed them is the devil, the harvest is the end of the age, and the reapers are the angels.

0:36:24

Oh, all of a sudden, we are starting to think, huh. The guys who are standing on the sea of glass, waiting for the bowl plagues to be poured out, is that the end of the age? Nope, no it isn't. So, here we are talking about the third harvest.

0:36:51

⁴⁰Therefore as the tares are gathered and burned in the fire, so it will be at the end of this age.

Is there an extinction level event at the end of the age, where the lake of fire is in place? Yes. Is there a lake of fire event going on when the barley is raised? Nope, there is no mention of it.

0:37:12

There is no mention of the lake of fire after the tribulation resurrection of the wheat. It's not there. This is in place at the final harvest; it says so.

⁴¹The Son of Man will send out His angels, and they will gather out of His kingdom all things that offend, and those who practice lawlessness, ⁴²and will cast them into the furnace of fire. There will be wailing and gnashing of teeth.

0:37:44

An extinction event.

⁴³Then the righteous will shine forth as the sun in the kingdom of their Father.

Spirit beings who have their own brilliance. So, you see the separation here in this final harvest of both.

0:38:03

If we go down to Matthew 13, verse 47.

⁴⁷"Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a dragnet that was cast into the sea and gathered some of every kind, ⁴⁸which, when it was full, they drew to shore; and they sat down and gathered the good into vessels, but threw the bad away. ⁴⁹So it will be at the end of the age. The angels will come forth, separate the wicked from among the just, ⁵⁰and cast them into the furnace of fire. There will be wailing and gnashing of teeth." ⁵¹Jesus said to them, "Have you understood all these things?" They said to Him,

Yup, yup, we got this; we didn't get it at all, from what I can see.

0:38:36

So, there is no lake of fire event, that I'm able to find, connected to the first two harvests. There certainly is to the third. Where else would you see a reference to the lake of fire event that goes with the third harvest, where would you turn? Where would you go? Well, let's try Matthew 25.

³¹"When the Son of Man (verse 31) comes in His glory, and all the holy angels with Him, then He will sit on the throne of His glory. ³²All the nations will be gathered

before Him, and He will separate them one from another, as a shepherd divides his sheep from the goats. ³³And He will set the sheep on His right hand, but the goats on the left. ³⁴Then the King will say to those on His right hand, 'Come, you blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world:

They received their spirit life. And you can read about the goats, and they go into the lake of fire. (verse 41) Can we begin to join the dots. The best I understand it, all three resurrections to spirit, are completed; the Feast of Tabernacles pictures the last harvest of mankind, not the first.

0:40:14

And then you got the Eighth Day, it's an outflow, it's not a harvest. The Feast of Tabernacles is the harvest, the Eighth Day is not a harvest. It is a holy day and it represents a new beginning, a return to the condition in the garden. What would have happened if Adam would have made the right choice, instead of the wrong choice?

0:40:45

How would that have played out? Well, the thousand years is the answer to that, that's how it plays out. And we are actually told who is the actual physical feed stock to start that new period of time. It means you are going to have this spirit or lake of fire incident, well there's nobody left that's physical. So, who starts the new show?

0:41:24

Actually, it turns out, we're told, and I believe it's been hidden by the old paradigms we had in place. So, let's go to Isaiah 65 and see if we can see this same pattern again. Isaish 65:1.

¹ "I was sought by those who did not ask for Me; I was found by those who did not seek Me. I said, 'Here I am, here I am,' to a nation that was not called by My name. ² I have stretched out My hands all day long to a rebellious people, who walk in a way that is not good, according to their own thoughts; ³a people who provoke Me to anger continually to My face; who sacrifice in gardens, and burn incense on altars of brick; ⁴who sit among the graves, and spend the night in the tombs; who eat swine's flesh, and the broth of abominable things is in their vessels; ⁵who say, 'Keep to yourself, do not come near me, for I am holier than you!' Rich talked about patience, or God exhibiting self-control. It's fair to say that here He is a little choked, wouldn't you say? Okay, so, He's been sitting back watching the show, and He is not real impressed. Let's go on.

⁶"Behold, it is written before Me: I will not keep silence, but will repay—

There is going to come a time when fur is going to fly.

even repay into their bosom—⁷your iniquities (those still alive) and the iniquities of your fathers

When it finally comes showtime, it's all going to happen.

Well, maybe some of these guys will turn the corner here.
